Recycling

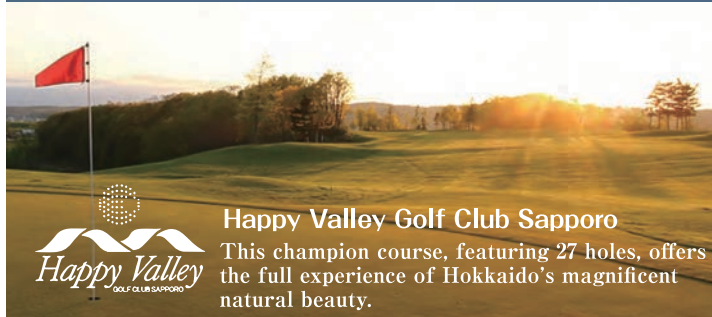
PET Bottles Caps
