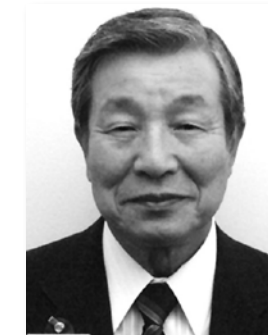

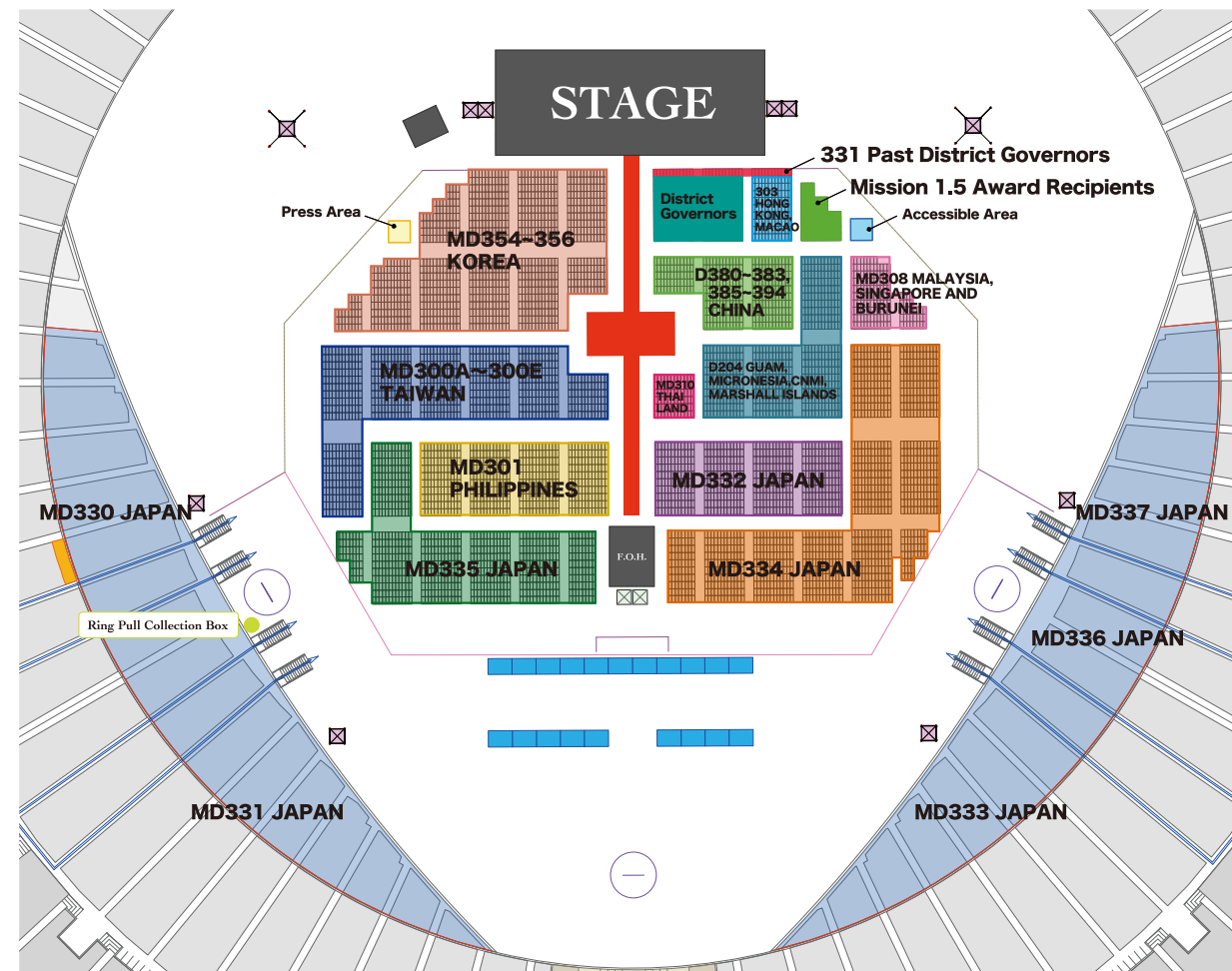

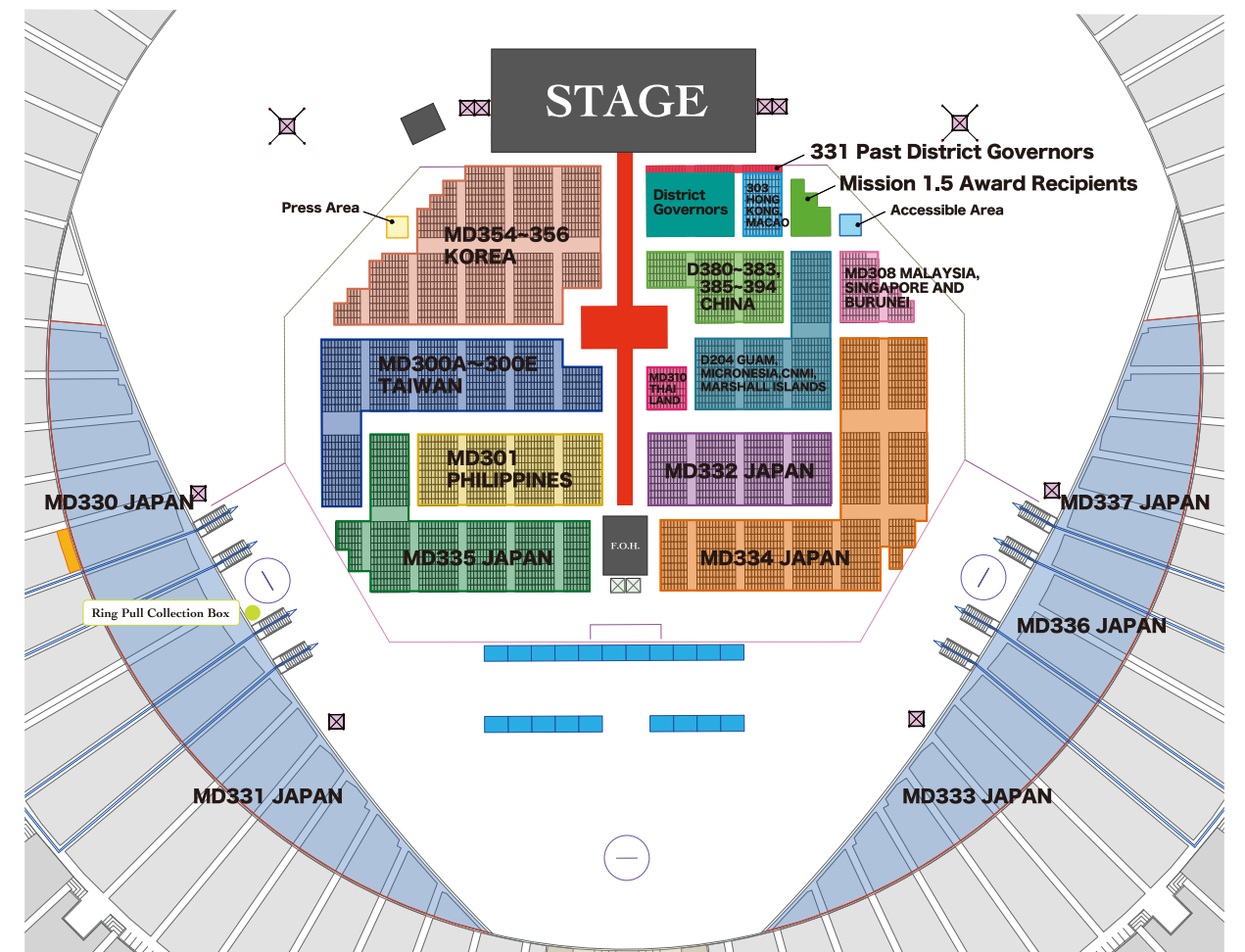

Forum Articles

ARTICLE I INTERPRETATIONS

1.1 OSEAL

OSEAL shall mean Orient and Southeast Asia Lions comprised of Lions Clubs duly chartered by the Lions Clubs International in all Districts (provisional, sub-single & multiple) in the following countries / geographical areas:

Guam, Micronesia, Saipan, Republic of Palau

Taiwan

Republic of the Philippines

Hong Kong & Macau

Malaysia & Brunei

Singapore

Thailand

Japan

Republic of Korea

People's Republic of China

Mongolia (Note 1)

Cambodia (Note 1)

Lao People's Democratic Republic (Note 1)

Socialist Republic of Vietnam (Note 1)

(Refer to Article X Section 1 0.03 hereunder for breakdown of Districts by the country or geographical area)

Note 1 - Mongolia, Cambodia, Lao People's Democratic Republic & Socialist Republic of Vietnam do not have enough membership count to meet the criteria to form a district.

1.2 OSEAL FORUM

OSEAL Forum shall mean the annual meeting of the lions in the Orient and Southeast Asia region held in a duly appointed Host District among the Member Districts. OSEAL Forum maybe abbreviated to read as 'Forum'.

OSEAL EXCUTIVE COMMITTEE

1.3 FORUM ORGANIZING COMMITTEE

A Forum Organizing Committee (F.O.C.) shall be formed by the Host District to organize and manage the respective Forum with the advice of the Steering Committee. The Forum shall be chaired by a Chairperson appointed by the Host District and shall be called the F.O.C. Chairperson'.

1.4 JOINT GROUP OF COUNCIL CHAIRPERSONS AND DISTRICT GOVERNORS

The 'Joint Group of Council Chairpersons and District Governors' shall comprise of all Council Chairpersons and District Governors of Member Districts. A Council Chairperson or District Governor may appoint an alternate to fill his/her absence and shall inform the Forum Chairperson accordingly ahead of the scheduled Meeting.

1.5 DISTRICT

District shall mean a provisional district, sub-district, single district or a multiple district in the region of the Orient and Southeast Asia area.

1.6 HOST DISTRICT

Host District shall mean the District which is hosting the Forum.

ARTICLE II OBJECTS

2.1 LIONISM

To promote Lionism in the Orient and Southeast Asia area with due consideration given to International Lionism and the promotion of the objects of Lions Clubs International and the current goals of International President.

2.2 FELLOWSHIP

To Promote better inter-regional and international understanding and friendship in line with the International Purposes and Code of Ethics.

2.3 ACTIVITIES

OSEAL shall be non-political, non-sectarian and non-racial in character, and shall not be involved in any activities contrary to the above.

2.4 OPERATION

Operation shall be within the Constitution, By-Laws and Purposes of the Lions Clubs International and shall not create any structure over and above the District and the Multiple District organizations.



ARTICLE III MEMBERSHI

3.1 MEMBERSHIP OF OSEA

Membership shall be composed of Lions Clubs duly chartered by Lions Clubs International in any of the Member Districts as defined in Article I Section 1.01 of these Forum Articles.

ARTICLE IV STEERING COMMITTEE

4.1 COMPOSITION

Each Forum shall form a 'Steering Committee' to be comprised of members as follows:

(a)The Forum Chairperson of Host District to serve as the Chairperson of the Steering Committee

(b)The Forum Chairperson of the Immediate Past Forum

(c)The Forum Chairperson of the Next Incoming Forum

(d)The Council Chairpersons as follows:

(i)Four Council Chairpersons from Japan to be selected from the Council Chairpersons of MD 330 to 337 from among themselves

(ii)One Council Chairperson from Korea to be decided between MD 354 & 356

(iii)Two Council Chairpersons from Taiwan to be selected from the Council Chairpersons of MD 300A to MD 300E

(iv)The Council Chairpersons from MD 301, 308 and 310

(e)District Governors of Single Districts 303, 204 and 309

(f)One Representative from Japan, Republic of Korea, and Mainland China

(g)The current International Directors of OSEAL region (1" year & 2" year)

(h)The current LCIF Trustees from the OSEAL region

(i)The current LCI Board Appointees from the OSEAL region

(j)The OSEAL Executive Committee Members

(k)The Forum Vice Chairpersons of Host District (maximum of 4)

(l)The Host District may invite other Lions dignitaries to attend as non-voting ex-officio members or observers, and may include the following:

(i)OSEAL Coordinating Office Manager

(ii)Host District Executive Committee, Working Committees & Advisers

4.2 TERM OF SERVICE, FUNCTIONS &RESPONSIBILITIES

The Term of Service of the Steering Committee with its members is One Year ending upon the close of the Forum. The Steering Committee shall have the following Functions:

(a)To help finalize the Agenda of the Forum submitted by the Forum Organizing Committee (F.O.C.)

(b)To help finalize the Estimated Budget for the Forum submitted by F.O.C.

(c)To help finalize the adoption of Logo and Theme for the Forum submitted by F.O.C.

(d)To help in finalizing the Programs and activities submitted by F.O.C. aiming at encouraging registration and greater participation by the delegates to the Forum proper.

(e)To help F.O.C. on matters regarding dissemination of information and proper guidance and creation of awareness on the Forum.

4.3 ADVISORY CAPACITY

The Steering Committee is to act only in an advisory capacity to the F.O.C.

4.4 VENUE OF MEETINGS

Meetings of the Steering Committee shall be held in the Host District.

4.5 TIME OF MEETINGS

The Steering Committee shall meet at least once to be held in the month of June or July after the close of the International Convention in the year when the Forum is to be held; and may be followed by a second meeting prior to or during the said Forum as the F.O.C. deems necessary.

4.6 EXPENSE

The F.O.C. shall prepare the budget to answer for the costs of the preparation and holding of each Steering Committee, provided, all expenses incidental to or in connection with the attendance thereat by the members and participants shall be borne by the individuals concerned. However, the F.O.C. may extend hospitality at its own expense to member or guest in attendance.



ARTICLE V FORUM ORGANIZING COMMTTEE (F.O.C.)

5.1 FORUM ORGANIZING COMMITTEE (F.O.C.)

The Host District of each annual OSEAL Forum shall form a Forum Organizing Committee (F.O.C.) no later than two (2) months from the close of the last preceding Forum.

5.2 FORUM ORGANIZING COMMITTEE CHAIRPERSON (Forum Chairperson)

A Forum Organizing Committee Chairperson shall be appointed by the Host District and the appointment shall be confirmed at the meeting of the 'Joint Group of Council Chairpersons and District Governors' five (5) years prior to the particular Forum concerned. After such confirmed appointment, the F.O.C. Chairperson cannot be replaced unless he/she resigns or becomes incapacitated. However, the F.O.C. Chairperson may designate his representative to attend the meeting in case of his unavailability. Further, the F.O.C. Chairperson shall also be the Forum Chairperson.

5.3 FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The F.O.C. shall have the following functions and responsibilities:

- (a)To take charge of the overall planning, organizing and preparing works for the Forum, with the advice of the Steering Committee and guided by Robert's Rules of Order on procedures.
- (b)To prepare and submit to the Steering Committee at least four (4) months before the scheduled Forum the following:
 - (i)An Agenda for the Forum
 - (ii)A Theme and Logo for the Forum (theme song-optional)
 - (iii)An Estimated Budget for the Forum (to include Registration Fee)
 - (iv)Schedule of Activities of the Forum
 - (v)Programs for the Forum (Ceremonies, sessions, etc.)
 - (vi)Programs and activities aiming at encouraging registration and greater participation by the delegates to the Forum proper.
 - (vii)Programs regarding dissemination of information and proper guidance and creation of awareness on the Forum 5.

5.4 BUDGETING, SURPLUS AND DEFICIT

Generally budgeting the Forum should not aim at profit making nor incur deficit. Any Surplus from income proceedings may be disposed of in whatever manner appropriate by the Host District; while any deficit shall be borne by the Host District, which altogether will be reflected in the Audited Statement of Proceeds and Expenditures mentioned in above Section 5.03 (c).

5.5 REGISTRATION FEE

Generally budgeting the Forum should not aim

5.6 DUES AND DONATIONS

The F.O.C. shall not collect dues of any kind but may accept any voluntary donation.

5.7 F.O.C. HOSPITALITY

The F.O.C. shall extend hospitality in providing complimentary accommodation and meals for the International President or his representative attending the Forum; and may offer such hospitality to any other distinguished guest invited to the Forum.

ARTICLE VI OSEAL FORUM

6.1 ANNUAL OSEAL FORUM

The F.O.C. Host District shall convene One (1) meeting in the calendar year to be known as the annual OSEAL Forum as defined in above Article I Section 1.02.

6.2 BIDDING FOR THE HOSTING OF ANNUAL OSEALFORUM

- (a)A Forum Planning Committee separate from the Forum Organizing Committee shall be established and supervised by the OSEAL Executive Committee, to receive and review all bids submitted by interested parties to host an annual OSEAL Forum.
- (b)Decision on the choice of bidder shall be made by a simple majority vote of the members present at the 'Joint Group of Council Chairpersons and District Governors'.
- (c)Annual OSEAL Forum shall be held in the Host District awarded the hosting of the Forum.

6.3 DATE

The period and dates for the holding of the Forum of the current year shall be decided by the Host District of that Forum.

6.4 FORUM PRESIDE

The F.O.C. Chairperson shall also preside over the Forum proper as the Forum Chairperson.



6.5 FORUM PROGRAMS AND SESSIONS

The programs and sessions of the Forum shall include the following:

- (a)Opening Ceremony
 - (b)Meeting of the 'Joint Group of Council Chairpersons and District Governors' (at least twice)
 - (c)Panel Discussions
 - (d)Closing Ceremony
 - (e)Session to vote on Forum Articles amendment, if any.
 - (f)Any other session deemed necessary by the F.O.C. with prior advice from the Steering Committee.
- ### 6.6 RESOLUTIONS AND DECISIONS
- (a)Resolution shall be proposed in writing by the OSEAL Executive Committee or a Council Chairperson/District Governor of a single District to the F.O.C. Chairperson at least one
 - (1)month prior to the convening date of the Forum.
 - (b)Each proposed resolution shall be seconded by another Council Chairperson /District Governor or member of OEC
 - (c)Adoption of the proposed resolution shall be by a simple majority vote of the 'Joint Group of Council Chairpersons and District Governors'.
In the event of a tie vote, the Forum Chairperson or Presider shall cast vote to break the tie.
 - (d)Upon notice of urgency, resolutions may be proposed and seconded and adopted by a majority vote in a quorum constituted meeting.
 - (e)All resolutions adopted at the meeting of the 'Joint Group of Council Chairpersons and District Governors' shall be reported at the Closing Ceremony of the Forum by the Chairperson of the Resolutions Committee.
 - (f)Resolutions adopted at the Forum without due notice shall not be valid or binding.

6.7 OFFICIAL LANGUAGE

- (a)The official language of the Forum shall be English language for all matters or businesses relating or pertaining to the Forum.
- (b)The Host District may provide for interpretation or translation into Japanese, Korean, Chinese and other such languages as may be deemed necessary.

6.8 SUB-COMMITTEES AND RESOLUTIONS COMMITTEE

A meeting of the 'Joint Group of Council Chairpersons and District Governors' may be called whenever deemed necessary to perform any special assignment, by one or more Sub- committees, including the Resolutions Committee which consist of no more than 9 persons representing the OSEAL area. The Chairperson of the Resolutions Committee shall be from the Host District. The sub-committees so created shall each consist of three to five members appointed from among the Council Chairpersons and District Governors.

ARTICLE VII RULES OF PROCEDUR

7.1 ORDER OF BUSINES

The printed official program of the Forum shall be the Order of Business of the Forum.

7.2 ROBERT'S RULES OF ORDER

Except where otherwise expressly provided herein, the Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised, shall govern all questions of procedure on the proceedings at the Forum.

7.3 ORDER OF BUSINES

- (a)DELEGATES: All delegates shall have registered with the Forum and paid the Forum Registration Fee.
- (b)VOTING DELEGATES : Only OEC members, International Directors, Council Chairpersons and District Governors from the OSEAL Region have the right to vote. When a person holds more than one position, he/she shall be recognized for the highest position held.
- (c)FORUM BADGE AND CREDENTIALS: Eligible Voting Delegates shall each be issued a credential and a Forum Name Badge which is to be worn by the Voting Delegate at all times during the Forum.
- (d)NON-VOTING DELEGATES: All registered delegates who are not eligible to vote shall be considered as Non-voting Delegates of the Forum.

7.4 VOTING

Each Voting Delegate may cast one vote on any Forum issue. A simple majority vote by the delegates at any quorum constituted session or meeting shall be sufficient to decide on issues brought before it; unless in the instance elsewhere in these Constitution and By-Laws that requires a majority vote of greater proportion to decide or adopt.

7.5 SPEECHES

All speeches by delegates shall be restricted to a duration of not more than three (3) minutes each, which may be extended by permission from the Chairperson or presider of the meeting or session. For the convenience of the delegates, simultaneous translations are preferred.



ARTICLE VIII ‘JOINT GROUP OF COUNCIL CHAIRPERSONS AND DISTRICT GOVERNORS’

8.1 COMPOSITION

The composition of ‘Joint Group of Council Chairpersons and District Governors’ shall as defined in above Article I Section 1.04

8.2 MEETING

The meeting of the ‘Joint Group of Council Chairpersons and District Governors’ shall be convened at least once at every Forum to deliberate and decide on all matters related to OSEAL.

8.3 QUORUM

The quorum of meeting shall be one-half (1/2) of the membership of the ‘Joint Group of Council Chairpersons and District Governors’ including OEC members, International District and the Forum Chairperson, or their designated representatives accredited or permitted by the Forum Chairperson and having registered with the Forum.

8.4 CHAIRPERSON

The Chairperson shall be the Forum Chairperson who may designate a representative.

8.5 INVITATIONS

International Executive Officers may be invited to attend the meeting of the ‘Joint Group of Council Chairpersons and District Governors’.

ARTICLE IX AMENDMENT

9.1 PROCEDURES

Any proposed amendment to these Forum Articles shall be made in writing to the F.O.C. Chairperson at least three (3) months prior to the meeting of the ‘Joint Group of Council Chairpersons and District Governors’ at the annual Forum; and shall be circulated by the Chairperson to all Council Chairpersons and District Governors at least one (1) month prior to the said meeting at the Forum.

9.2ADOPTION

Amendments to these Forum Articles shall be adopted by an affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the votes cast by Voting Delegates present at the meeting of the ‘Joint Group of Council Chairpersons and District Governors’.

9.3 EFFECTIVITY

Amendments shall take effect at the close of the OSEAL Forum where adopted.



ARTICLE X MISCELLANEOUS

10.1 SUPREMACY OF THESE FORUM ARTICLES

(a)These Forum Articles shall be written or printed in the English language, and may be translated by the member Districts into one’s own preferred language. In case of conflict arising between the translated versions and this English version, the latter shall prevail.

(b)In case of conflict between these Forum Articles and Lions International Constitution and By-Laws, the latter shall govern.

10.2 HOUSE-KEEPING RESOLUTIONS

To give due course to the situational development and/or changes that would necessitate proper revisions to the Forum Articles to keep it abreast with the actual rules and practices traditionally and customarily observed by the Forum, or as may be dictated by the rules or policies of Lions Clubs International, such revisions could be effected without formal amendment but simply by resolutions aim for house-keeping purposes and referred to as House-keeping Resolutions. Such resolutions may be presented by the Forum Chairperson and be adopted by a simple majority vote at the ‘Joint Group of Council Chairpersons and District Governors’. The subject matter of the resolution may involve the following:

(a)(Re-numbering and/or re-arranging the provisions in the Forum Articles.

(b)Updating the list of Multiple Districts and Districts that would fall under the OSEAL region by adding the names or designations of the new multiple districts and districts to the Forum Articles.

(c)To Reflect the correct number of Council Chairpersons and District Governors in the OSEAL Region in view of the new Multiple Districts and Districts that are added to the Region.
